2) Displaying a clear "Visual Message"

3) Writing a well structured "Story Message" with a good introduction, body, and conclusion.

The course will focus onstrategies for creating and delivering presentations, and plentyof English language support will be provided by the textbook andthe teacher as needed.
授業の進め方・方法	Every two weeks, we will practice a different technique for displaying confidence in English presentations, such as making good eye contact, showing natural gestures, using audience-friendly visual aids, and so on. Each technique will be practiced in a short (2-minute) speech. Then, all of the techniques will be combined and used for a final, 5-minute English presentation.
