In the second semester, they will begin to develop their Japanese writing skills by researching and understanding the topics the teacher has prepared for them, and practicing how to write their own thoughts in writing. The students will continue to practice writing during class time and supplementary classes in order to produce well-formed characters that are easy for the reader to read. Grade evaluation method : The results of the first and second semester exams (70%), assignments (20%), and attendance (10%) will determine the overall evaluation. A score of 60 or more is considered a passing grade, and the student will be required to retake the exam if necessary.
