There is a Mini test every week.

Exams (80%) + Mini tests (10%) + Portfolio (10%).

Examinations will be conducted a total of 4 times, and the evaluation ratios will be the same. The Evaluation ratios for modern Japanese literature, classical Japanese literature, classical Chinese (kanbun), and Japanese expressions will be shown each time. As a general rule, retaking exams can not performed.

A mini test is conducted every week, and the average score is included in the grade. As a general rule, retaking mini test can not performed.

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Portfolio work will be completed during classtime and during long vacations. Details will be given each time.

Precautions on the enrollment: Students must take this class (no more than one-third of the required number of class hours missed) and earn the credit in order to complete the 2rd year course. As a preparatory study, read a book of any genre. However, it should not be a manga or something with little text. Get familiar with the act of reading. Read the textbooks and read aloud before class to see if there are any parts you do not understand. Every week, you will take a mini test, so be sure to study and take the mini test. Actively participate in classes and make efforts to increase your knowledge of Japanese. Notice Foundational subjects: Japanese in elementaryschool and junior highschool, Related subjects: Japanese II (2nd) Japanese III (3rd) Japanese IV (4th year), Theory of Japanese Culture (4th), Theory of Cross-cultural Society I (4th) If you are late for the start time, you will be treated as absent after 20 minutes. If you are absent, submit a notification of absence or official notification of absence. If there is no notification of absence, the mini test of the week will be 0 points. Submit assignments on time.

Try to improve your thinking and expressiveness by touching on various sentences on a daily basis. It is not allowed to use a dictionary on a mobile phone or smartphone during classes.
